titled much anticipated second collection determined as ever to make meaning from the perversity of suffering my second work is rare in its ability to be both completely idiosyncratic and widely resonant as lowe transforms experiences of shame disgust and bewilderment into a kind of mutant hope poems in this collection have appeared in the new yorker and poetry and were honored by the poetry society of america the debut collection of poems by bridget lowe includes bibliographical references p 203 205 in her debut picture book misty copeland tells the story of a young girl an every girl whose confidence is fragile and who is questioning her own ability to reach the heights that misty has reached misty encourages this young girl s faith in herself and shows her exactly how through hard work and dedication she too can become firebird lyrical and affecting text paired with bold striking illustrations that are some of caldecott honoree christopher myers s best work makes firebird perfect for aspiring ballerinas everywhere in the wake of an infection that has left baton rouge unsettled and roiling with the undead three young friends mazoch vermaelen and rachel band together to search for mazoch s missing father their mission is to visit all the places he once lingered his favourite fast food
