for the bicentennial captain

beefheart s on the eight track
and the hot new film king
suckerman has everyone
talking two knockaround guys
named clay and karras are out
looking for trouble when they
stumble onto a drug deal gone
bad and end up with a pile of
money that isn't theirs when
the well armed dealer starts
spilling blood to get to the cash
clay and karras must take a
stand go straight and get
justice or maybe just sweet
revenge a brilliant novel from

one of america s finest literary crime writers on a hot summer afternoon in washington dc 1972 three white teenagers stoned and fearless drive a stolen car into a rough black neighbourhood taunting local black kids through the car window they speed off to what they think is safety they find themselves trapped in a dead end street whilst an angry mob gathers in the ensuing chaos two of the white boys manage to escape but billy the third friend is shot dead thirty five years later one of these men reaches out to another opening a door that could lead to salvation however another survivor of that day is now out of prison and is looking for

reparation in any form he can find it crime fiction writer george pelecanos introduces spero lucas an anti hero making his place in the world one battle at a time includes a bonus work of short fiction focusing on spero s early life spero lucas has a new line of work since he returned home to washington d c after serving in iraq he has been doing special investigations for a defense attorney he s good at it and he has carved out a niche recovering stolen property no questions asked his cut is forty percent a high profile crime boss who has heard of lucas s specialty hires him to find out who has been stealing from his operation it s the biggest job

spero has ever been offered and he quickly gets a sense of what s going on but before he can close in on what s been taken he tangles with a world of men whose amorality and violence leave him reeling is any cut worth your family your lover your life the first in a series of thrillers featuring spero lucas the cut is the latest confirmation of why george pelecanos is perhaps america s greatest living crime writer stephen king a gritty urban crime thriller from one of the award winning writers of the wire like most of the trouble in nick stefanos life it started with a drink lying in the darkness drunk and immobile nick hears two men murder a terrified

teenager when he wakes in the morning his memory is blurred but the dead boy is still there submerged in the river the police presume it's a gang killing no shortage of them in DC but Nick isn't sure gangs don't use silencers hit men do despite not having worked a pi case for a year and a half Nick starts investigating driven by an obsessive need for the truth and with each clue he unearths he's driven further into the darkest corners of the human soul the third novel in the Nick Stefanos series a riveting crime novel from one of the writers of *The Wire* Washington DC 1972 Derek Strange has left the police department and set up shop as a private investigator

thrown off his game by a kid from the local slum an aging loser takes a last stab at respectability by becoming a police informant a greek american couple adopts an interracial trio of sons and then struggles to keep their family together giving us a stirring bit of background on one of pelecamos most beloved protagonists spero lucas in the title novella which takes its name from hollywood slang for the last shot of the day the one that comes before the liquor shots begin we go behind the scenes of a television cop show where a writer gets caught up in a drama more real than anything he could have conjured for a script by turns

heartbreaking and humane brutal and funny these finely constructed tales expose the violence and striving beneath the surface of any city and within any human heart tough sexy fast paced and crackling with energy the martini shot is pelecans at his very best the first in a stunning action packed series from one of the writers of the wire spero lucas has a new line of work since he returned home after serving in iraq he has been doing special investigations for a defence attorney he s good at it and he has carved out a niche recovering stolen property no questions asked his cut is 40 a high profile crime boss who has heard of lucas s speciality hires

side room and a withered black face receded into the darkness the face belonged to a junkie named tonio morris he was one of the many bottom of the food chain junkies near death and too weak to cut out a space of their own on the second floor later when the packets were delivered to those with cash they d trade anything they had anything they d stolen that day or any orifice on their bodies for some rock or powder when pi derek strange is hired by chris wilson s mother to find out why her son a black cop was killed by a white cop terry quinn on a dark night inthat no man s land strange figures that the answer is painfully clear a typical case of mistaken

identity fueled by the assumptions and preconceptions of Quinn's innate racism but what strange finds is a tentative kinship with Quinn who is desperate to proclaim himself color blind kicked off the force and convinced that there's more to his own story Quinn asks to join strange in his investigation as the two pry into the past drifting through the neighborhoods both men have known all their lives they find themselves enmeshed in a tangle of cold blooded competition and heated personal enmity Pelecanos generally has a light touch with the treacherous quagmire of isms veering only occasionally

into sententious meanderings about the consequences of an economically and racially divided society his wry humor particularly in his descriptions of Earl and Ray the heroin middlemen who bring the concept of white trash to a depressingly low level leavens the novel's noir bleakness and strange himself is a compelling character a middle aged black man who has seen more of life scallousness than he cares to admit and whose jitteriness about personal commitment speaks volumes about his own expectations for happiness a strong character and a good read Pelecanos fans can settle in and look forward to strange's next appearance Kelly Flynn a

stylish and gripping crime novel from one of the acclaimed writers of the wire part time PI Nick Stefanos doesn't tail wives anymore but when a childhood friend steps into Nick's bar after 15 years and asks for help locating his wife April he feels obliged to do some digging after a visit to the small time crime boss with whom April was supposedly having an affair Nick realizes there is far more to this story than a missing wife there is missing money lots of it and some very powerful enemies a brilliant novel from one of America's finest literary crime writers his books will burn into your brain like no others Washington Post Lorenzo Brown

is fresh out of the clink the former drug enforcer has vowed to go straight and found himself a job as an officer for the humane society he patrols downtown dc looking for ill treated pets but in the course of his day repeatedly comes face to face with his old life rachel lopez is an attractive young probation officer brown is one of her clients but also fast becoming one of her friends perhaps he is one that can be saved nigel johnson is a smart young drug dealer on the make he has plans to make a lot of money and stay alive to spend it he already runs his neighbourhood but doesn't realise that he stands on the brink of a vicious turf war

which could destroy him from these basic players pelecamos weaves an amazing novel one that defines a generation of black hispanic and white americans fighting literally for their lives washington dc 1946 for two local young men pete karras and joey recevo the easiest way to find work after the war is by providing a little muscle for a local boss who runs a protection racket with the mafia the trouble with pete karras is that he is just too soft on his fellow immigrants and the last thing the boss wants is for his mob to get soft the boys have to teach karras a painful lesson that he won't forget three years later pete and joey meet up once more and a final

confrontation puts the meaning of friendship and honour to the ultimate test the big blowdown is the first novel in pelecamos's acclaimed washington quartet in this superbly crafted dc noir hard drinking nick stefanos is hired to find a friend's missing wife if he doesn't hit rock bottom first nick stefanos has given up his job in sales to tend bar at the spot where drinks and women are both a bit too easily available and the routine is starting to feel as dead end as his last gig but things are about to change first his high school friend billy goodrich asks him to find his wife april who he says left him for small time crime boss joey digeordano in fact april has

taken off with hog farmer
bondage freak tommy crane
and it turns out with 200 000 of
digeordano family money there
are powerful enemies on her
trail and now on nick s trail too
discover the early work of the
emmy nominated writer from
the wire and the deuce whose
authentic sense of place sharp
musical references and
hardboiled style make him one
of the most acclaimed in the
mystery genre perhaps the
greatest living american crime
writer stephen king after the
carusos family home is
destroyed by police with a no
knock warrant the family
struggle to return to normal
two former inmates reunite on
a tv set they re both back on

the straight and narrow until
one sees the potential for an
easy grift a teenage boy must

pelecanos portraits are

most violent city a bent cop and
a missing teenage girl turned
hooker but then a senseless
death on a sunny afternoon
shakes even derek strange s
existence a victim shot down by

bullets meant for another a tragic accident that strikes just too close to home strange s grief is all consuming and he swears to track down and destroy the killers ghetto style but as he throws himself deeper and deeper into the hunt he has to ask questions of himself and his world that he would rather not in yet another gem of urban noir the bestselling author and writer for the award winning hbo hit the wire explores the possibility of making the turnaround of starting over and building a new life regardless of the past four blistering novellas drawn together by themes of strife violence and humanity from esteemed crime

fiction writer george pelecinos like his hero elmore leonard pelecinos finds the humanity in the lowest of lowlifes chicago tribune when the son of the carusos is involved in a hold up the family home comes under siege in the form of a no knock warrant months after the cops destroyed their home the carusos struggle to return to normal elsewhere two former inmates reunite by chance on the set of a tv production both have found their way on the straight and narrow path that is until one sees the potential for an easy grift a teenage boy must step into the man he d like to be as a hostage crisis grips his hometown a woman adrift meets a man tied to her

grandmother s past an encounter that awakens her to a bloody history that undergirds the place she grew up pelecinos portraits are characterized by shades of grey resisting the mold of heroes and villains victims and perpetrators good and evil at once streetwise and full of heart owning up grapples with random chance the bind of consequence and the forked paths a life can take don carpenter s hard rain falling is as tough as nails account of being down and out but never down for good a dostoyevskian tale of crime punishment and the pursuit of an ever elusive redemption the novel follows the adventures of jack levitt an

orphaned teenager living off his wits in the fleabag hotels and seedy pool halls of portland oregon jack befriends billy lancing a young black runaway and pool hustler extraordinaire a heist gone wrong gets jack sent to reform school from which he emerges embittered by abuse and solitary confinement in the meantime billy has joined the middle class married fathered a son acquired a business and a mistress but neither jack nor billy can escape their troubled pasts and they will meet again in san quentin before their strange double drama comes to a violent and revelatory end like the kind of cars they don't make anymore and the kind of

songs they don't sing the novels of george pelecanos have the style rhythm and muscle of classics shoedog is vintage pelecanos a tale that throbs with soul and pulsates with menace constantine was born in d c and has been traveling the world ever since finding everything but a home randolph has stayed in this city every day selling shoes in a downtown store taking care of ladies who lie about their sizes and sometimes fit him into their beds now these two strangers one white one black have come together in a criminal's audacious plan with five partners and the hit ready to go down constantine doesn't understand the treacheries

feuds and fantasies swirling around him and he's fallen for a woman who only doubles his risk but randolph a self-confessed shoedog can smell trouble a mile away and when the shooting starts he'll give constantine a chance to live or die where he was born when a yacht explodes in the bahamas apparently killing six people sam boyleston an attorney from texas and the brother of one of the victims is compelled to investigate the circumstances as does raoul kelly a newspaper reporter after the disaster the yacht's burned captain was temporarily marooned on a small island and soon it becomes apparent that one person is ruthlessly

manipulating events but for Boyleston and Kelly proving guilt appears impossible a major suspense novel New York Times from the poet laureate of the DC crime world Esquire comes this powerful early novel the noirish story of how a Washington DC liquor store heist shows a drifter named Constantine what it means to be a shoedog every man has his dark side Spero Lucas confronts his own in an explosive thriller from the writer of the award winning *The Wire* Spero Lucas is a young Iraq war vet now working as a PI in Washington DC he's hired by a young woman to find a painting she lost after being scammed by a super smooth con artist Spero

tracks the painting down but the con artist is part of a team of ruthless thugs and the woman who hired Spero is brutally attacked as a warning to stay away the warning doesn't work Spero is angry and he goes on the offensive taking out the gang one by one but where do Spero's remorseless killings sit on the morality scale is he defending an innocent woman or have his experiences of war turned him into a ruthless killer no better than the crooks he's up against the first in the excellent Strange and Quinn series from the coolest writer in America GG Derek Strange and Terry Quinn are ex-cops turned private detectives in Washington DC

gunman frank farrow has other
ideas now the heat has died
down he is on his way back to
washington determined to
avenge his lost brother by
killing everyone involved in his
death this is a wonderful
powerful novel that deserves to

win an oscar time out it s the
spring of 1968 the sun shines
down on an america on the
brink of civil war martin luther
king preaches in vain for non
violent protest and the ghettos
of washington dc seethe with
anger in the middle of this
powder keg is thrust a young
black cop barely out of school
himself derek strange believes
passionately that he can make
a difference but his friends and
family think he s a traitor and a
patsy of the white
establishment on april 4th 1968
dr king is assassinated on the
balcony of his motel in
memphis tennessee and black
america rises as one to
condemn the slaying of their
hero for one week it seems that

the whole country will fall and
derek his brother his father his
mother and his whole
community find themselves at
the heart of a battle for the
heart and soul of the new world
when a young woman with a
sordid past witnesses a murder
she finds herself fascinated by
the killer and decides to track
him down herself amy was once
a party girl but she now lives a
lonely life helping the house
bound to receive communion in
the gravesend neighborhood of
brooklyn she stops in at one of
the apartments on her route
where mrs epifanio the elderly
woman who lives there says
she hasn t seen her usual
caretaker diane in a few days
supposedly diane has the flu or

so diane s son vincent said when he first dropped by and vanished into mrs e s bedroom to do no one knows what amy s brief interaction with vincent in the apartment that day sets off warning bells so she assures mrs e that she ll find out what s really going on with both him and his mother she tails vincent through brooklyn eventually following him and a mysterious man out of a local dive bar at first the men are only talking as they walk but then almost before amy can register what has happened vincent is dead for reasons she can t quite understand amy finds herself captivated by both the crime she witnessed and the murderer himself she doesn

t call the cops to report what she s seen instead she collects the murder weapon from the sidewalk and soon finds herself on the trail of a killer character driven and evocative the lonely witness brings brooklyn to life in a way only a native can and opens readers eyes to the harsh realities of crime and punishment on the city streets like fiction cars take us into a different world from the tony enclaves of upper crust society to the lowliest barrio from muscle car driving con men to hardscrabble kids on the road during the great depression from a psychotic traveling salesman to a mexican drug lord who drives a tricked out vw bus we all share the roads

and our cars link us together including entirely new stories from michael connelly c j box george pelecanos diana gabaldon james sallis ace atkins luis alberto urrea sara gran ben h winters and joe lansdale the highway kind is a street level look at modern america as seen through one of its national obsessions in this epic showdown from one of the best crime novelists alive dennis lehane police officer derek strange hunts his brother s killer through a city erupting with rage one of the 1990s rising stars of crime fiction delivers a bold brilliant tale of mystery revenge and survival in the 1980s when cocaine and money ruled the city streets

and even the good guys wanted a piece of the action a great novel from one of america's finest literary crime writers they never found the killer all they knew back in the winter of 1985 was that someone was taking teenagers killing them and leaving their abused bodies in public parks three victims in all with no link between them except a oddity of their names they read the same back to front otto ava and lastly eve a lot has happened in the twenty years since detectives gus ramone and dan holiday two of the leads on the case have pursued very different paths gus has climbed to the heights of detective sergeant and built himself a reputation as a very

good cop whilst dan has been drummed out of the force his sleaze finally getting too much for his superiors however their paths are about to cross again a boy named asa a close friend of gus's teenage son has been found in the public park his skull shattered by gunfire now it seems that both men are once again in the path of this disturbed serial killer the night gardener is george pelecanos's stunning crime thriller the story of two very different men united by the maliciousness of a deadly attacker from writer and producer on hbo's the wire and the deuce comes one of the most critically acclaimed crime novels of the year he is quite simply among america's finest

crime writers this latest story does not disappoint lyrical beautifully observed and constantly surprising it is a delight daily mail in his first novel for five years pelecanos demonstrates why he deserves to be regarded as one of the best american crime novelists it's a moving tale beautifully told the times anna byrne is a jailhouse librarian in a place where hope is hard to find the power of books can be a light in the dark for some of the prisoners her work is life changing like michael hudson her best student who's been locked up awaiting trial before his sudden release he's relieved to be free to come uptown as they say but can't

elmore leonard powerful michael connelly i love the way he writes economical rhythmic elliptical and angrily political val mcdermid hard boiled fiction with heart sunday telegraph pelecanos has joined james lee burke and lawrence block at the high table of contemporary crime greats the times the coolest writer in america gq gold standard character driven crime writing that few will ever match financial times a young woman is brutally murdered and pis strange and quinn are forced to confront their own part in the crime private investigator derek strange and his partner terry quinn are running a pi business in the seedy

underbelly of washington dc are approached by a young man asking them to find his girlfriend who has gone missing and so strange and quinn find her just another day not quite in the grimy underworld inhabited by strange nothing is that simple for strange and quinn s efforts have led to a young mother being brutally murdered a devastating discovery that causes them both to question the morality by which they live and yet at the same time they need to continue the search for another missing girl a teenage runaway who shows up in a porn video and who hasn t been seen since bleak gritty and moving soul circus

superbly brings to life the devastating story of life and death in washington s black ghettos the double is as good as it gets the writing is taut the violence is graphic and the characters are so well drawn that they step off the page and into your life associated press every man has his dark side spero lucas confronts his own in the most explosive thriller yet from one of america s best loved crime writers the job seems simple enough retrieve the valuable painting the double grace kinkaid s ex boyfriend stole from her it s the sort of thing spero lucas specializes in finding what s missing and doing it quietly but grace wants more she wants

of short stories what really

whose basketball skills earn
him loyal friends and bitter
rivals the police informant
grappling with his own sick
conscience a helpless young
drug dealer watches as
violence seeps into the lives of

those who he cares about and a
writer on a tv cop show who
finds drama and reality are
colliding much too close to
home corruption revenge
honour sacrifice and the fight
to survive dark fast paced and
crackling with energy these

very best christopher flynn is
