international institute of public finance us taxation is a major issue in the economic and political spheres this book focuses on a sample of developing countries from asia and latin america that experienced an economic and democratic transition during the period 1990 2004 using a unique dataset the authors show that tax revenue is higher in more democratic regimes consistent with the standard view that democracies have to satisfy the redistributive needs of the electorate they also find that a second relationship between the level of democracy and the composition of taxes mainly direct versus indirect is much harder to predict however a comparison with new eu member states suggests that more mature democracies are associated with higher levels of direct tax this unique book in a relatively under researched subject area will prove essential reading for academics researchers and practitioners focusing on political economy public finance and the economics of taxation

2013-11-29 1 economical questions indisputably occupy a central place in everyday life in order to clarify these questions people generally turn to those who are familiar with economics in answering such legitimate questions economists propose explanations which rest on a few principles among which the rationality principle is by far the most fundamental this principle assumes that people are rational but what is meant by this has to be specified rationality and explanation in economics claims that only a minimal kind of rationality is required to animate economic explanations however such a conception of rationality faces serious objections it is closely associated with harshly criticised methodological individualism and it is not easily disentangled from sheer irrationality the book answers these objections and shows that the economists way of mobilising the concepts of maximization or of consistency for defining rationality raises more serious problems since

the latter have encouraged various attempts to downgrade or even to dispense with the very notion of rationality the book is largely devoted to countering arguments associated with these attempts and to show why postulating that agents are rational is still the only efficient way to explain economic phenomena as such the author also proposes original views about the role of rationality the meaning of methodological individualism the relevance of the selection argument and the Superstars relation between rational explanations of economics and explanations in natural sciences

covering the period 1993 to 2001 witnessed the first growth acceleration in the economy a second acceleration ran from 2002 to Superstars 2010 the fourth and final episode started with the slowdown in 2010 and continues to this day the book provides a theoretical framework that focuses on rent structures institutions and the polity and demonstrates how changes in these can explain the four growth episodes kar and sen argue that the transitions from one growth episode to another can be explained by the bi directional relationship between growth outcomes and institutional arrangements and by the manner in which institutional arrangements and their transitions are determined by the political bargains struck between the elite groups in indian society
