ultimately it is terek the principled doctor tending to yehia s case who must decide whether to follow protocol as he has always done or to disobey the law and risk his career to operate on yehia and save his life written with dark subtle humor the queue describes the sinister nature of authoritarianism and illuminates the way that absolute authority manipulates information mobilizes others in service to it and fails to uphold the rights of even those faithful to it
