*Clark'S Tables: Science Data Book* 2006-09 william andrews clark was born 8 january 1839 in connellsville fayette county pennsylvania to john and mary andrews clark both john and mary were of scotch irish descent and mary claimed a strain of huguenot blood their parents were born in county tyrone ireland but soon after the revolution they settled in america p 7 in march 1869 john married katherine stauffer also of connellsville the clarks lived in several areas including chicago illinois and st louis missouri where william engaged in business before eventually settling in montana in montana he became a sucessful mining magnate at one time owning six mines in several states other business enterprises included banking public utilities lumbering cattle raising and beet sugar production p 80 katherine stauffer clark died in 1893 after having become involved in political affairs for some years in 1901 clark was sworn in as united states senator from montana p 97 he married anna eugenia lachapelle on may 25 1901 p 100 in marseille france at the age of eighty six william andrews clark died of pneumonia at his fifth avenue new york city new york house march 2 1925 he was the last of the pioneers who had made fortunes in the west p 88 descendants lived in new york california and elsewhere

novels wilhelm meister s journeymanhsip goethe articulates the need to balance all such self involved behavior with an attitude of self denial apparently the mind can orient itself through centers of purpose order and power but it must also recognize the illusion of their attainment identity does not involve a substantive presence and the result of self definition for goethe is interpretive work each of professor muenzer s interpretations has been guided by this premise the interests of all of goethe s novelistic protagonists he concludes serve as orienting postures toward goals that cannot be literally achieved consequently symbolic resolutions are proposed these then introduce new problems as points of departure in subsequent works the hidden agenda of goethe s work as a novelist is a self that exists as a textual problem a series of interpretive moves that endlessly defer the attainment of self presence by supplementing each other in narrative fictions

[Official Register of the United States](#) 1892 nicholas fox weber author of the acclaimed patron saints exhilarating avant garde entertainment sam hunter the new york times book review and balthus the authoritative account of his life and work michael ravitch newsday gives us now the idiosyncratic lives of sterling and stephen clark two of america s greatest art collectors heirs to the singer sewing machine fortune and for decades enemies of each other he tells the story as well of the two generations that preceded theirs giving us an intimate portrait of one of the least known of america s richest families he begins with edward clark the brothers grandfather who amassed the clark fortune in the late nineteenth century a man with nerves of steel a sunday school teacher who became the business partner of the wild inventor and genius isaac merritt singer and by the turn of the twentieth century was the major stockholder of the singer manufacturing company we follow edward s rise as a real estate wizard making headlines in 1880 when he commissioned manhattan s first luxury apartment building the house was called clark s folly today it s known as the dakota we see clark s son alfred enigmatic and famously reclusive at thirty eight he inherited 50 million and became one of the country s richest men an image of propriety good husband father of four in europe he led a secret homosexual life alfred was a man with a passion for art and charity which he passed on to his four sons in particular sterling and stephen clark sterling the second oldest buccaneering and controversial loved impressionism created his own museum in williamstown massachusetts and shocked his family by marrying an actress from the comédie française together the sterling clarks collected thousands of paintings and bred racehorses in a highly public case sterling sued his three brothers over issues of inheritance and then never spoke to them again he was one of the central figures linked to a bizarre and little known attempted coup against franklin delano roosevelt s presidency we are told what really happened and why and who in american politics was implicated but never prosecuted sterling s brother stephen self effacing and responsible became chairman and president of the museum of modern art and gave that institution its first painting edward hopper s house by the railroad thirteen years later in an act that provoked intense controversy stephen dismissed the museum s visionary founding director alfred barr who for more than a decade had single handedly established the collection and exhibition programs that determined how the art of the twentieth century was regarded stephen gave or bequeathed to museums many of the paintings that today are still their greatest attractions with authority insight and a flair for evoking time and place weber examines the depths of the brothers passions

the vehemence of their lifelong feud the great art they acquired and the profound and lasting impact they had on artistic vision in america

**The Clarks** 1941 clarks reach extends to all corners of the globe and yet it remains a family owned business firmly rooted in its quaker origins unlike other well known quaker firms like cadburys now part of us giant kraft founded in 1825 by two brothers cyrus and james clark the company began as a rug making operation in the then tiny village of street somerset one day james clark began making slippers from off cuts of rugs and found that people wanted to buy them slippers became shoes and boots and a business was born over the years it has had its ups and downs but it has always strived to remain true to its quaker values in its commitment to the well being of its workforce and the local community schools libraries and recreation halls were built and trade unions banned as the sun set on the british empire clarks opened up new frontiers across the world clarks brand logo became one of the most famous in the world every parent in the 1950s swore by clarks shoes for their children as well as buying them for themselves but increased competition from within the uk and overseas saw concerns for the future heightened during the 1980s a hostile bid for the company in the early 1990s saw the board and the family split eventually shareholders voted to reject the bid the company was reorganised with all its lines made outside the country this resulted in the closure of all its uk factories and the laying off of hundreds of clarks employees but the outcome has been a transformation in the company s fortunes in 2010 its profits were over 100 million and its retro desert boots and other styles have become the height of fashion especially in china and america
