the novel s first complete appearance was in book form in 1878 widely regarded as a pinnacle in realist fiction tolstoy considered anna karenina his first true novel fyodor dostoyevsky declared it flawless as a work of art his opinion was shared by vladimir nabokov who especially admired the flawless magic of tolstoy s style and by william faulkner who described the novel as the best ever
